## **Second Reading of Ordinance 1-18**

Mr. Winslow read the resolution and commented that the City of Fort Wrights position supports that of the Mayor's Group.

Mayor Hatter stated that the meeting was last Saturday and that the Resolution which Mr. Butler wrote, encompasses all that was said at the meeting and was met with positive feedback. This resolution will serve as a template for other cities. He plans to email it out to other cities.

Motion by Mr. Abeln; second by Mr. Feinauer to approve. Roll call vote taken, Mr. Abeln, Mr. Feinauer, Mr. Wall, and Ms. Witt voting in favor; no one opposed. Motion passed.
