
Mr. Klein advised that the purpose of this Public Hearing was to receive public comment on the expected Municipal Road Aid funds to be received from the state in the amount of \$82,000.00 in receipts and \$1000.00 in interest for a total amount of \$83,000.00 for street repairs in the City. We are proposing to spend this money on repairs to Barbara Circle which is the next street in our five year plan. This also needs to be done because of storm water and sewer work scheduled for this year as part of the Lorup Avenue rehab work.
