KCPC Recommendation Concerning Walmart's request for Property Modifications Involving the Addition of Parking and Building Space to Accommodate Online/Mobile Order Pickups.

Walmart is seeking an additional 4,973 square feet of pickup spaces for their online/mobile pickups. It would include an additional 31 spaces dedicated to pickup only and it would include signage. Once SD1 has approval, PDS will start with the next stage of development plan for the parking spaces.
