# **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

Resignation of BOA member Jeff Wolnitzek – Mayor Hatter advised Mr. Wolnitzek has submitted his resignation from the Board of Adjustment, citing ongoing health concerns. Mayor Hatter advised he will be pulling together suggestions for Mr. Wolnitzek's replacement and welcomed Councilmembers to submit suggestions. He said he would also approach the remaining members of the Board with their suggestions and hopes to bring a list of individuals for review at the next meeting.

Ms. Bailey added that the person selected by Council would be appointed to fill the unexpired term that lasts through December 31, 2023, and then could be reappointed through the normal process of Council approval.

# **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

Finance Committee – Councilman Wessels had no report.

Community Improvements Committee – Councilwoman Witt and Ms. Bailey presented information on three Fort Fit walking routes through the City, all originating at the City Administration Building with differing mileage. Ms. Bailey proposed some signage, including stenciling on the ground at the City Administration Building, saying she anticipates spending less than \$3,000 on the project. Council expressed no opposition to the project.

There was discussion on the TANK bus stops in the City and the option for the City to put their own in to replace the existing structures. Ms. Bailey and Councilwoman Witt agreed to continue exploring options for updating the existing bus stops.

# **CAO REPORT**

Ms. Bailey advised the Cincinnati Bell lease agreement negotiations have wrapped up and the lease has been signed by all parties effective through December 31, 2023, for which Cincinnati Bell will pay \$1,800. She added that fiber installation will be occurring at the City Administration Building this week.

# **DEPARTMENT REPORTS**

**Public Works** – Mr. Bethell advised the Northern Kentucky Water District anticipates being finished with their work on Fort Henry in early August. He also presented updated signage that will be posted at road projects moving forward.

# **COUNCIL COMMENTS**

Councilman Wessels – requested to know the staff procedures for write-off of delinquent taxes, so the Finance Committee can be made aware.
