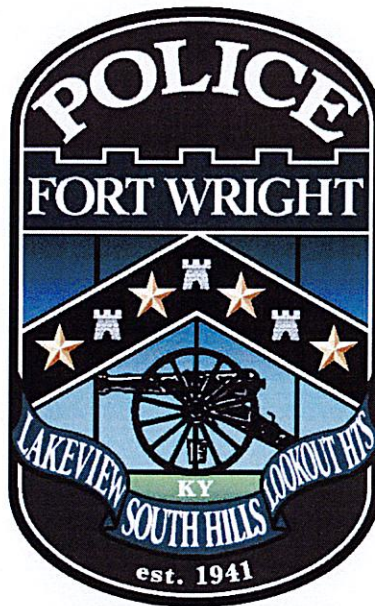


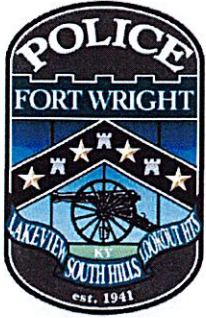

As we close out 2025, I am proud to share the accomplishments and progress of the Fort Wright Police Department. This year has been defined by our unwavering commitment to safety, professionalism, and community partnership.

Community engagement remained a cornerstone of our mission. From senior scam prevention classes and bike rodeos to holiday events like Trunk or Treat and Cram the Cruiser, we worked tirelessly to strengthen trust and build meaningful connections with residents. These programs demonstrate that policing is most effective when rooted in partnership.

Our team invested heavily in continuing education, completing over 1,000 hours of training, and our leadership earned national recognition through the FBI LEEDA Trilogy Award. These achievements reflect our focus on accountability and excellence.

Operationally, we continue to grow our investigative capabilities with several investigated and closed cases with a dedicated Detective position, improving case resolution and victim support. Our Evidence Room achieved a 100% audit score, and we passed a CJIS compliance audit, underscoring our commitment to integrity and security.

Fiscal responsibility guided our decisions. We acquired two new Dodge Durangos at a savings of \$5,000 compared to last year and secured nearly \$30,000 in ballistic armor and equipment through grants—enhancing officer safety without burdening taxpayers.

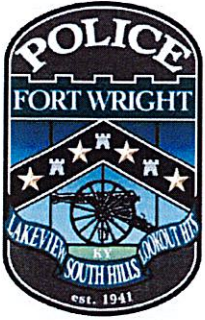
In 2025, our officers responded to thousands of calls, issued hundreds of citations, served 39 warrants, and managed nearly a thousand traffic collisions. Through proactive policing and community first strategies, we continue to make Fort Wright a safe place to live, work, and play.

MISSION STATEMENT

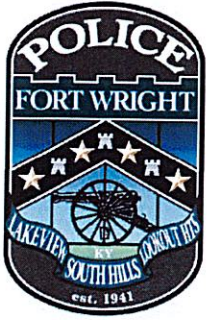

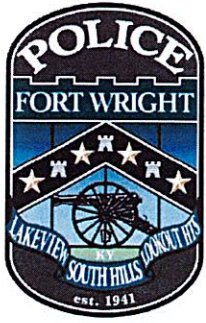


As we close out 2025, the Fort Wright Police Department (FWPD) is proud to report that the agency continues to work on reaccreditation through the Kentucky Association of Chiefs of Police (KACP), with the department's first accreditation awarded in 2000. Reaccreditation reflects FWPD's continued commitment to professional excellence, accountability, and service to the Fort Wright community.

The KACP Accreditation Program is a well-established, comprehensive process designed to help law enforcement agencies evaluate and strengthen their overall operations. Accreditation is based on clearly defined professional standards that guide policies, procedures, and daily practices. Participating agencies conduct an in-depth review of their operations to ensure alignment with these standards, followed by a rigorous assessment conducted by independent law enforcement professionals. Successful completion of this process results in formal recognition by an authoritative body that the agency meets or exceeds accepted best practices in law enforcement.

The KACP Law Enforcement Accreditation Program remains one of the most effective and cost-efficient tools available for enhancing agency professionalism and effectiveness. Accredited departments benefit from consistent, proven procedures, well-defined policies, and efficient operational practices. Just as importantly, accreditation reinforces public confidence by demonstrating to residents that their police department is committed to maintaining the highest standards of service, integrity, and professionalism.

In accordance with KACP requirements, law enforcement agencies must undergo the accreditation process every four years. The Fort Wright Police Department completed its most recent onsite assessment during the summer of 2023, during which agency operations and policies were thoroughly reviewed. The successful outcome of that assessment and subsequent reaccreditation underscore FWPD's dedication to continuous improvement and its ongoing mission to serve the community with excellence as we move forward beyond 2025.

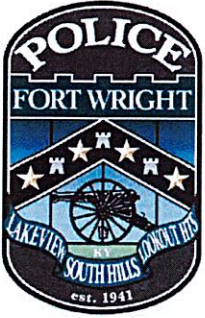

STAFFING CHANGES



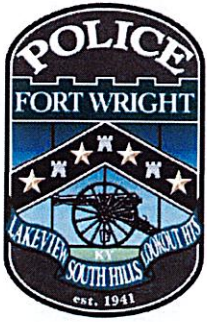
Police Officer Jared Capps

Department Citation for assisting a family in need during the passing of a loved one. They both then got support from the community and wrapped gifts for the young children during Christmas.



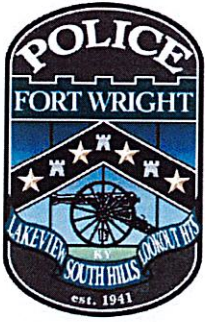
OFFICER DESIREE GETZ

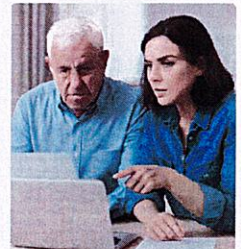
STAY SAFE FROM SCAMS!

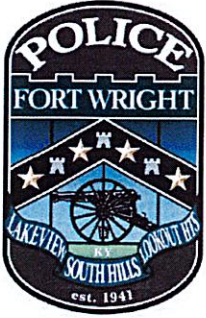


LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

The Fort Wright Police Department places a strong emphasis on leadership development as a cornerstone of a professional and progressive agency. Sergeant Nick Von Handorf recently attended and graduated from the Kentucky Department of Criminal Justice Training (KYDOCJT) Academy of Police Supervision, a rigorous three-week intensive course focused on first-line supervision. The program emphasizes leadership fundamentals, effective communication, accountability, and decision-making, providing supervisors with the tools needed to lead officers confidently and responsibly in today's policing environment.

At the executive level, Chief Jonathan Colwell and Captain Robert Griffin have both attended and graduated from the FBI LEEDA (Law Enforcement Executive Development Association) programs as well as the FBI National Academy Associates (FBINAA) Leadership Certificate Program. These nationally recognized programs focus on executive leadership, organizational management, ethical decision-making, and strategic planning, while fostering collaboration with law enforcement professionals from across the country. As a result of both command staff members completing the full FBI LEEDA trilogy of leadership programs, the Fort Wright Police Department has received the prestigious FBI LEEDA Trilogy Award, recognizing the department's commitment to excellence and dedication to developing strong, effective law enforcement leaders.

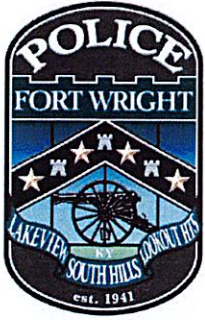


INVESTIGATIONS

The Fort Wright Police Department recently created a dedicated Detective position, marking a proactive and progressive step forward for the agency. This position has strengthened the department's ability to conduct in-depth investigations, follow up on complex cases, and address ongoing criminal activity with greater focus and continuity. By expanding investigative capacity, the department has created a new outlet for problem-solving and accountability that benefits both officers and the community they serve.

The addition of a Detective has also allowed the Fort Wright Police Department to regularly attend and actively participate in Financial Investigation Association (FIA) meetings, Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT) meetings, and Tri-County Investigation meetings. This involvement improves information sharing, strengthens partnerships with other agencies, and enhances coordinated responses to complex cases. Overall, this proactive approach increases case clearance rates, improves victim support, and reinforces public trust. Below are just a few of the cases successfully closed in 2025 as a result of these efforts.

- Stolen Vehicle Investigation – Lexus stolen and later recovered; suspect identified and successfully convicted.
- Theft by Deception / Stolen Mail – Investigation on W. Crittenden resulting in suspect identification.
- Theft by Unlawful Taking (TBUT) – 16 Glazier Rd; suspect entered a neighbor's residence and stole silver items.
- Stolen Vehicle – Ford truck stolen from Shell station on Dixie Highway; vehicle recovered in Ohio after suspect crashed it; suspect charged.
- Accidental Shooting – 1611 St. Anthony; incident resulted in the death of an unborn child.
- Theft Over \$10,000 – Vehicle break-in at Bob Sumerel Tire.
- Financial Fraud – Theft from victim's savings account at Guardian Savings totaling approximately \$9,000.
- Sexual Assault / Strangulation – Investigation on E. Henry Clay.
- Major Violent Crime – Highland Avenue; charges include rape, strangulation, unlawful imprisonment, assault 2nd degree, and sodomy 1st degree.
- Fraud Investigation – Valley Drive; victim loss exceeding \$15,000.

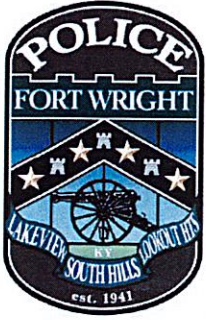


EVIDENCE CONTROL AND INFORMATION AUDITS

The Fort Wright Police Department takes great pride in the management and security of its Evidence Room, which serves as a critical component of the department's investigative and operational integrity. The Evidence Room is overseen by Detective Gross, who serves as the evidence custodian, with support from Evidence Technician Officer Desiree Getz, and overall supervision provided by Sergeant Nick Von Handorf. The department currently holds hundreds of items of evidence, ranging from physical items collected at crime scenes to sensitive documents, all maintained with strict chain-of-custody protocols. In 2025, the Evidence Room successfully underwent two full audits, achieving a 100 percent retention and accountability rate, reflecting the department's commitment to professionalism and meticulous evidence management.

In addition to internal audits, the Fort Wright Police Department underwent an on-site Criminal Justice Information System (CJIS) audit conducted by the Kentucky State Police, which we successfully passed. The audit evaluated numerous areas critical to law enforcement operations, including information sharing security, accountability and security of confidential information, data integrity, access controls, and compliance with federal and state CJIS policies. This accomplishment underscores the department's dedication to maintaining high standards for evidence handling, information security, and operational transparency, ensuring public trust and confidence in every aspect of its work.

POLICE EQUIPMENT

In 2025, the Fort Wright Police Department made several strategic equipment acquisitions that demonstrated strong fiscal responsibility and proactive planning. The department purchased two new Dodge Durango police vehicles, and through diligent market research, vigilant searching, and effective negotiations, was able to secure both vehicles for **\$5,000** less than the previous year's cost, despite overall vehicle prices increasing an estimated 2%. This achievement reflects the department's commitment to managing taxpayer funds carefully while still maintaining a reliable and modern fleet to support daily operations.

Additionally, the Fort Wright Police Department successfully obtained a grant through the Kentucky Attorney General's Office to fully replace ballistic armor that was set to expire during FY 2025–2026. The grant covered all required soft body armor, as well as eight special threat plates that enhance officer protection, and an additional ballistic shield. These critical safety upgrades were acquired at zero cost to the City of Fort Wright or its citizens. The estimated **savings include approximately \$13,000 in soft body armor, \$8,000 in special threat plates, and \$8,200 for the ballistic shield, resulting in a total savings of nearly \$30,000** while significantly improving officer safety and preparedness.

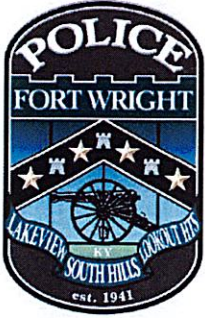
