Auditor's Report on Internal Control and Compliance

Internal Controls

- There are no material weaknesses in internal control
- There were 2 significant deficiencies in internal controls:
 - Lack of Segregation of Duties
 - City Clerk has control of cash and receipts, record-keeping, and reconciliation duties
 - The processes of executing a transaction (control), recording a transaction, and reconciling transactions should be segregated
 - Lack of Control over Financial Reporting
 - No accruals; no fixed asset depreciation, CERS, or compensated absence schedules; no listing of tax abatements

Compliance

 There are no instances of non-compliance with laws or grant or bond agreements

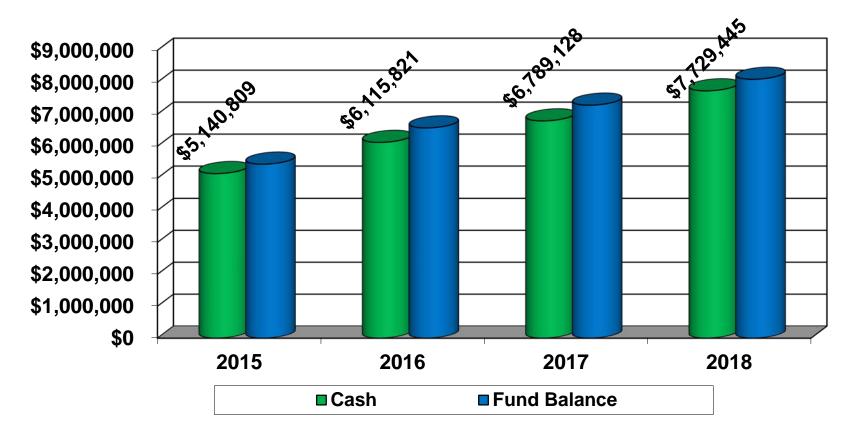


Auditor's Correspondence to Those in Charge of Governance

- Governance Letter was provided to and reviewed by the Finance Committee
- We were required to make numerous accrual adjustments, fixed asset and depreciation adjustments, correction of accounting errors, and CERS pension adjustments
- Seven (7) Management Comments were issued to management regarding controls

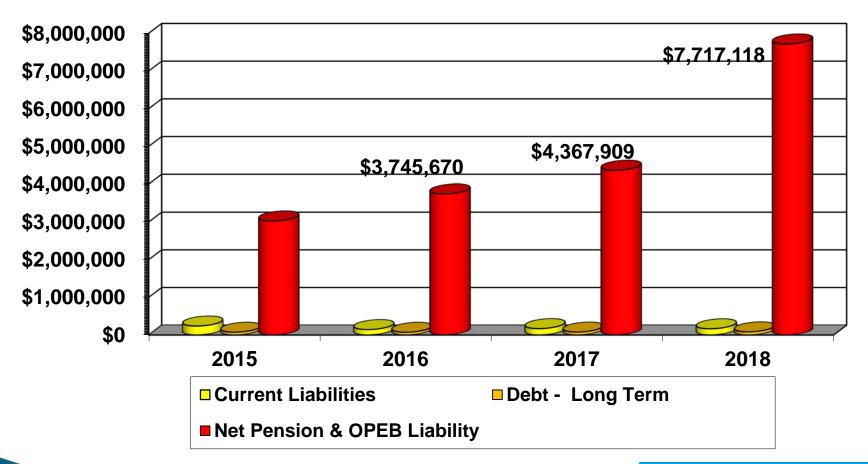


Asset Comparison All Governmental Funds As of June 30th



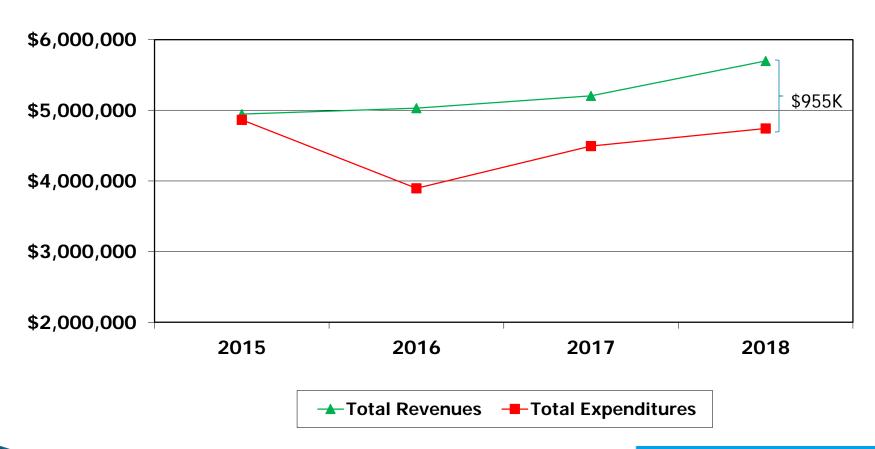


City Wide Debt Comparison - All Fund Types As of June 30th





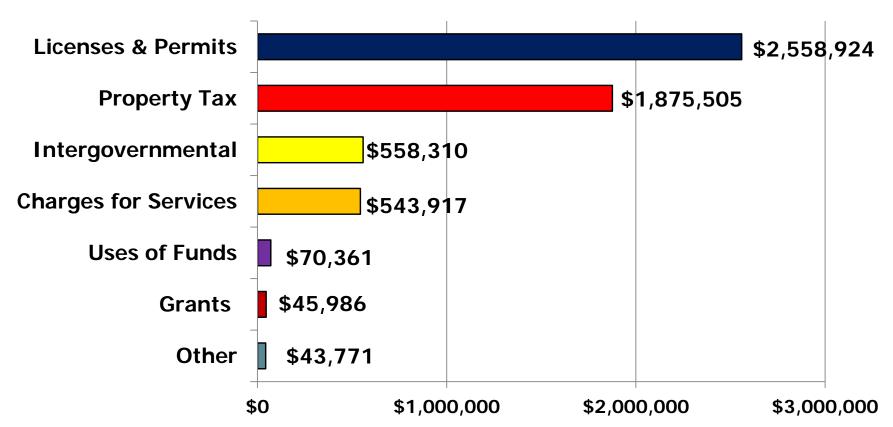
Revenues vs. Expenditures (All Sources) All Governmental Funds For the Years Ended June 30th





Revenues by Source - All Governmental Funds For the Year Ended June 30, 2018

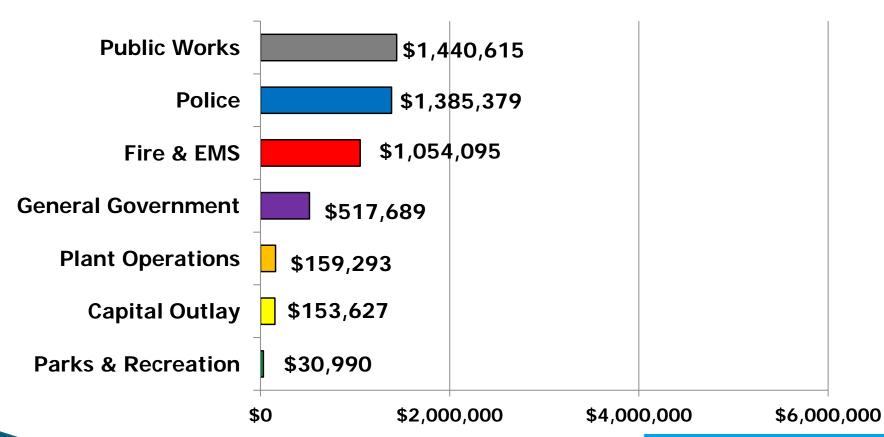
Total Revenues \$5,696,774





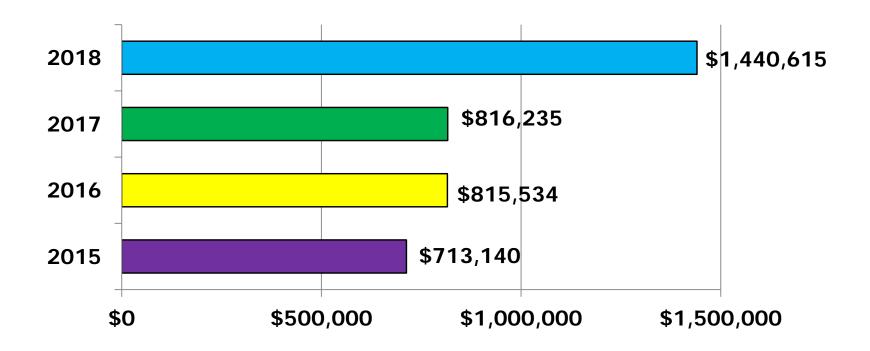
Expenditures by Dept. - All Governmental Funds For the Year Ended June 30, 2018

Total Expenditures \$4,741,688



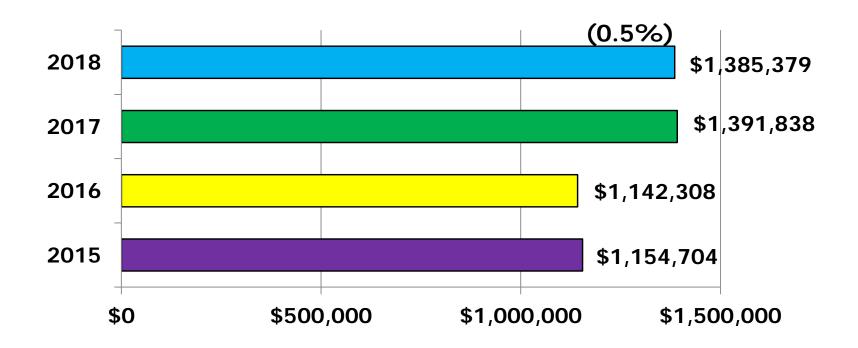


Public Works Expenditures - Yearly Comparison For the Year Ended June 30, 2018



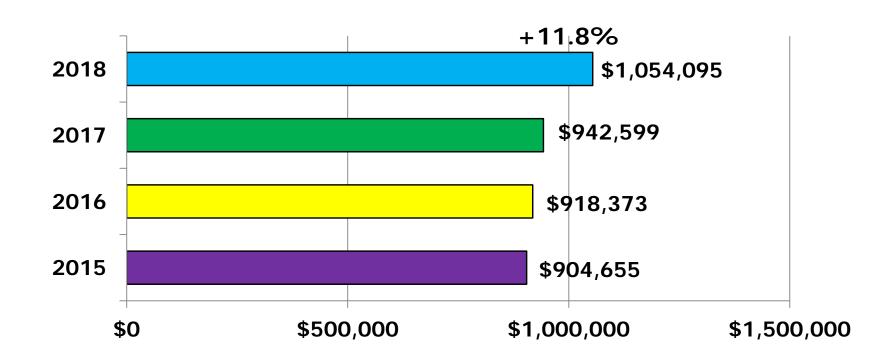


Police Expenditures - Yearly Comparison For the Year Ended June 30, 2018



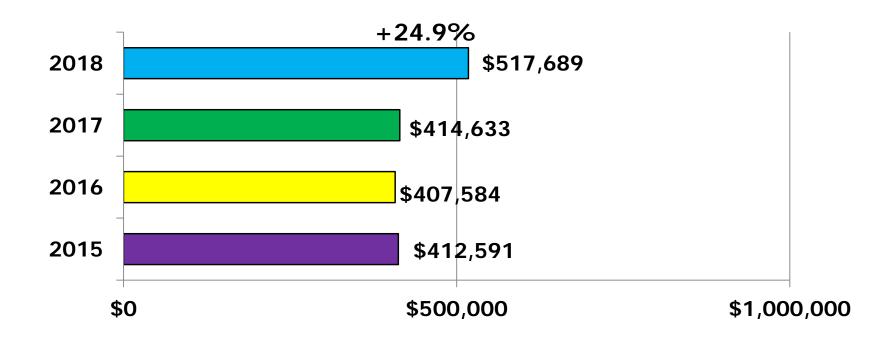


Fire & EMS Expenditures - Yearly Comparison For the Year Ended June 30, 2018
