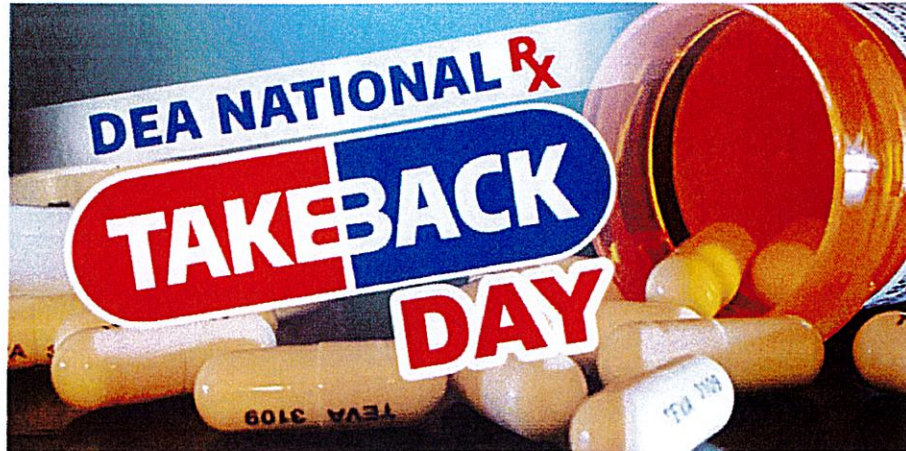

Fort Wright/Drug Enforcement Administration Drug Take Back Program



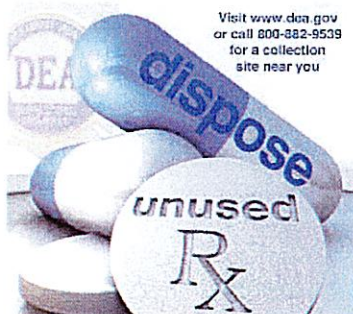
Purpose - The National Prescription Drug Take Back Day provides a safe, convenient, and responsible means of disposing of unwanted, unused, and expired medications. This initiative helps to prevent drug misuse and abuse, as well as, to protect the environment by ensuring proper disposal of pharmaceutical products.

How to Participate - Community member can bring their medications to designated collection sites across the country this Saturday, October 25, 2025 from 10 am to 2 pm at various locations around the region. The event is free and anonymous, with no questions asked. To find an event collection site near you, you can visit the DEA's Official Website at www.dea.gov Or;

Use the collection service all year long at the Fort Wright City Hall - 409 Kyles Lane, Fort Wright, KY 41011. The Fort Wright Collection Service is available Monday through Friday, from 8 am to 5 pm in the Administration Dept. Lobby for your convenience.

What to Bring - Participants are encouraged to bring any unwanted or expired prescription medications, including pills and patches. However, certain items like needles, sharps, and liquids can not be accepted. You are encouraged to remove personal information from the medication containers before disposal but this is not required.

Please help us keep old and unused drugs off the streets and out of our sanitation, and water systems.
