

## ORDINANCE 09-2022

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FORT WRIGHT, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, ADDING A SCHEDULE TO CHAPTER 74, ENTITLED TRAFFIC SCHEDULES OF TITLE VII, THE TRAFFIC CODE, OF THE CITY OF FORT WRIGHT TO CLOSE OFF OLD MADISON PIKE FROM VEHICULAR TRAFFIC SOUTH OF THE DRIVEWAY TO 3864 OLD MADISON PIKE, FORT WRIGHT, KENTUCKY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Fort Wright City Council finds that the condition of Old Madison Pike has deteriorated to the point where closure to vehicular traffic is necessary to protect the safety of the citizens of the area; and so City Council desires to amend its code of ordinances relating to its Traffic Code, codified in the City's Code of Ordinances as Title VII, specifically adding a "SCHEDULE III. STREETS CLOSED TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC", and closing Old Madison Pike to vehicular traffic in both directions at a point just south of the existing driveway accessing 3864 Old Madison Pike, Fort Wright, Kentucky.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF FORT WRIGHT, KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS.**

### SECTION 1

The Traffic Code of the City of Fort Wright TITLE VII, specifically Chapters 74, is hereby amended as follows (any text being added is shown by a single solid line drawn underneath it; text that is removed is marked at the beginning with an opening bracket and at the end with a closing bracket; the text between the brackets is stricken through with a single solid line).

### SECTION 2

**ADD THE FOLLOWING AFTER THE END OF EXISTING SCHEDULE II:**

#### **SCHEDULE III. STREETS CLOSED TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC.**

(A) No person shall cause, permit, aid, assist, encourage, or engage in the operation of a motor vehicle on the following streets at the locations identified:

<u><b>Street</b></u>	<u><b>Location</b></u>	<u><b>Direction(s)</b></u>
<u>Old Madison Pike</u>	<u>Between that point just south of the existing driveway to 3864 Old Madison Pike, and the city boundary to its south</u>	<u>Both directions</u>

(B) Any violation of the provisions of division (A) of this schedule shall be a violation and a fine of not less than \$20 nor more than \$100 shall be imposed for each offense.

### **SECTION 3**

City staff is directed to construct a barrier, post appropriate signage and undertake such other actions necessary to implement this ordinance.

### **SECTION 4**

Any and all Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance shall be, and hereby are, repealed to the extent of said conflict.

### **SECTION 5**


If any part of this ordinance or its application is deemed invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the city council intends that such invalidity will not affect the effectiveness of the remaining provisions or applications and, to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

### **SECTION 6**


That this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and shall be published under KRS 83A.060(9) and other applicable law. This ordinance may be published by summary.
